- ◆ How to work effectively alongside school staff and other professionals to achieve positive outcomes.

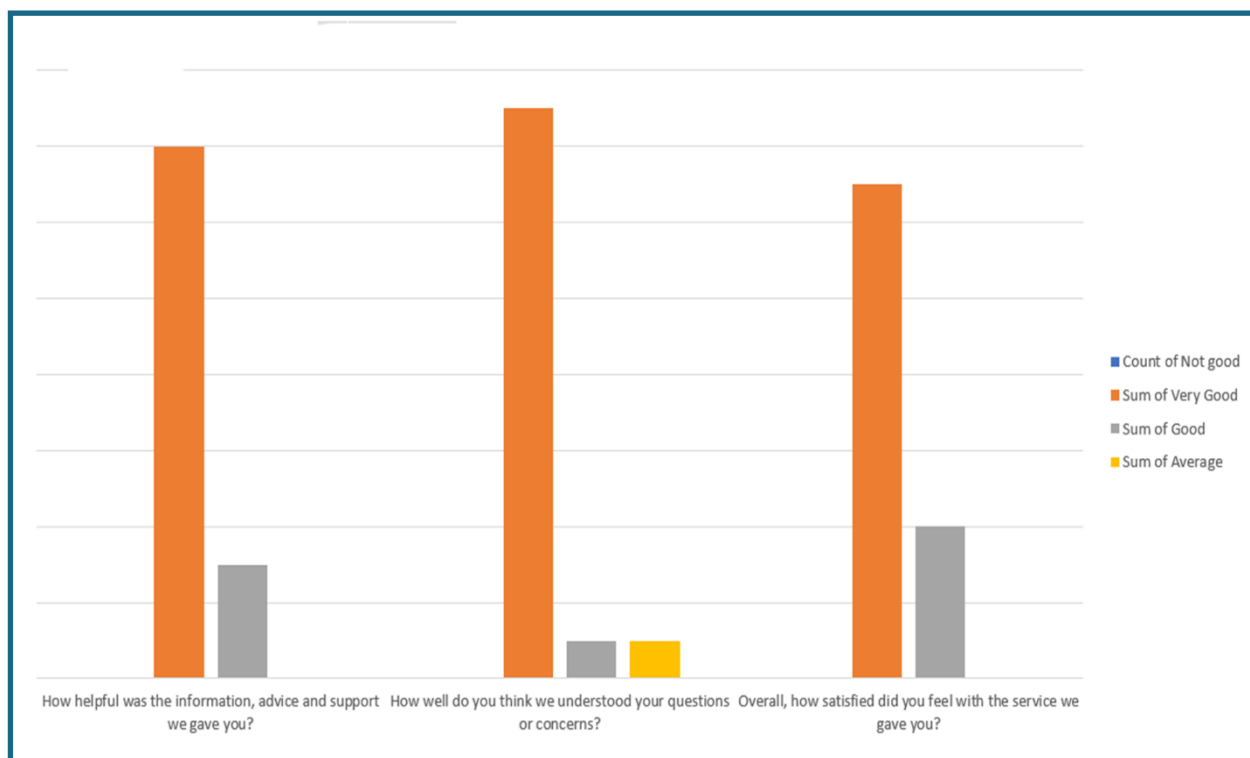
We are happy to cover any areas that you feel would be helpful to you and your parents.
